The project includes:

- Add one lane in each direction
- Add a median separation
- Provide bicycle lanes adjacent to travel lane in each direction
- Provide Sidewalks on both sides
- Shared Used Path to connect sidewalks to
 Withlacoochee State Trail at the north end of the project
- Restore Perimeter Trail for Whispering Pines Park and add Plantings
- Add new park Entrance for Whispering Pines Park at shopping center signalized intersection
- Add lighting to all signalized intersections
- Add a dedicated left turn lane for the southbound traffic to Inverness Middle School
