The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Seven, invites you to attend and participate in a Construction Open House for the Interstate 75 (I-75) ramp reconfiguration and interchange modification from State Road (SR) 574 (Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) to Interstate 4 (I-4) in Hillsborough County.

This project is building a barrier separating northbound I-75 from the SR 574 exit and entrance ramps. A two-lane northbound collector-distributor (CD) roadway is being built east of the current northbound lanes within the existing right of way. Traffic entering northbound I-75 at SR 574 will use the new CD road. The CD road will also serve motorists on northbound I-75 exiting to I-4. In addition to the improvements on I-75, the SR 574 interchange is being converted to a diverging diamond interchange.

Participate at your convenience at the locations and hours listed. Project staff will be available to answer questions in-person, by phone, and email.

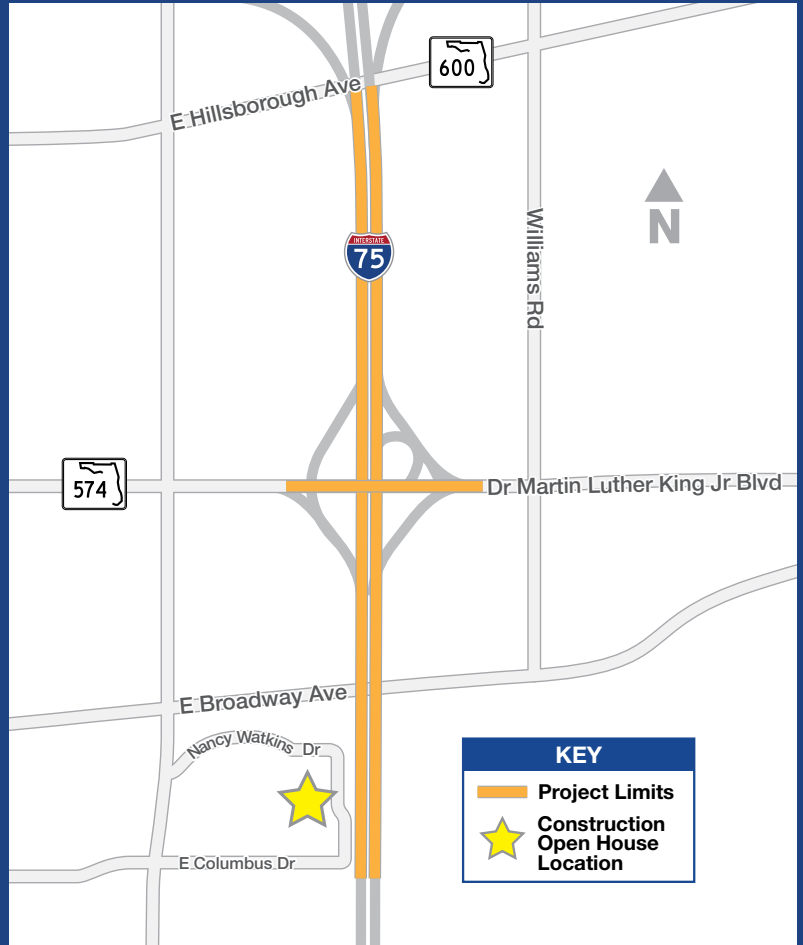
