




Before we begin the project presentation, we would like to share a few items to help online attendees participate in this meeting.




State Road 60






The Department of Transportation encourages the public to participate in this project by submitting comments.


Questions or comments can be submitted at any time during the meeting by typing into the Questions pane. Following the presentation, FDOT staff will answer questions verbally.




The purpose of this project is to enhance safety by constructing a directional median on State Road 60 at Horton Road and to extend the life of the roadway by repaving State Road 60 from Clarence Gordon Jr. Road to the Polk County Line, or South County Line Road.




The only location on the corridor where there will be a median change is at the intersection of State Road 60 and Horton Road where a directional median is proposed. That means drivers will only be allowed to make a left turn from State Road 60 onto Horton Road. Drivers coming from Horton Road will have to make a right turn, then a U-turn to travel in the other direction on State Road 60.



Those drivers turning right onto State Road 60 will see another median a short distance west of Horton Road, which will allow those westbound drivers to make that U-turn. Drivers traveling eastbound on State Road 60 will also be able to make a U-turn at that location or make a left turn into that private driveway.



This project is currently in design. Construction is anticipated to begin in late 2023.


