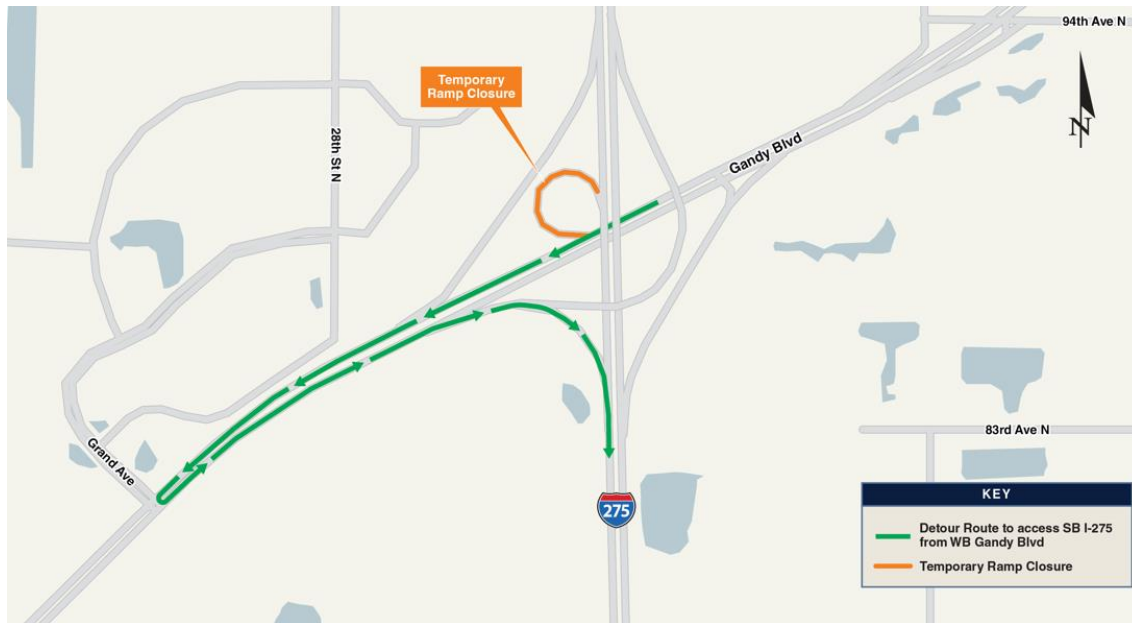

### **Westbound Gandy Boulevard Ramp to Southbound I-275 Closing** **Tuesday Night**

St. Petersburg, FL – Beginning at 8 p.m., Tuesday, January 16, the Florida Department of Transportation’s contractor will close the westbound Gandy Boulevard ramp to southbound I-275 in Pinellas County. This entrance ramp is expected to reopen before 6 a.m. Wednesday, January 17, weather permitting.



During this temporary ramp closure, motorists will continue west on Gandy Boulevard, make a U-turn at Grand Avenue, and continue east on Gandy Boulevard toward the southbound I-275 entrance ramp.

Electronic message boards and advance warning signs will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists should use caution while traveling through the work zone and remain alert for construction workers.

This closure is necessary for crews to perform paving operations as part of the SR 694 (Gandy Boulevard) repaving project from Grand Avenue to the east of I-275 in Pinellas County.
