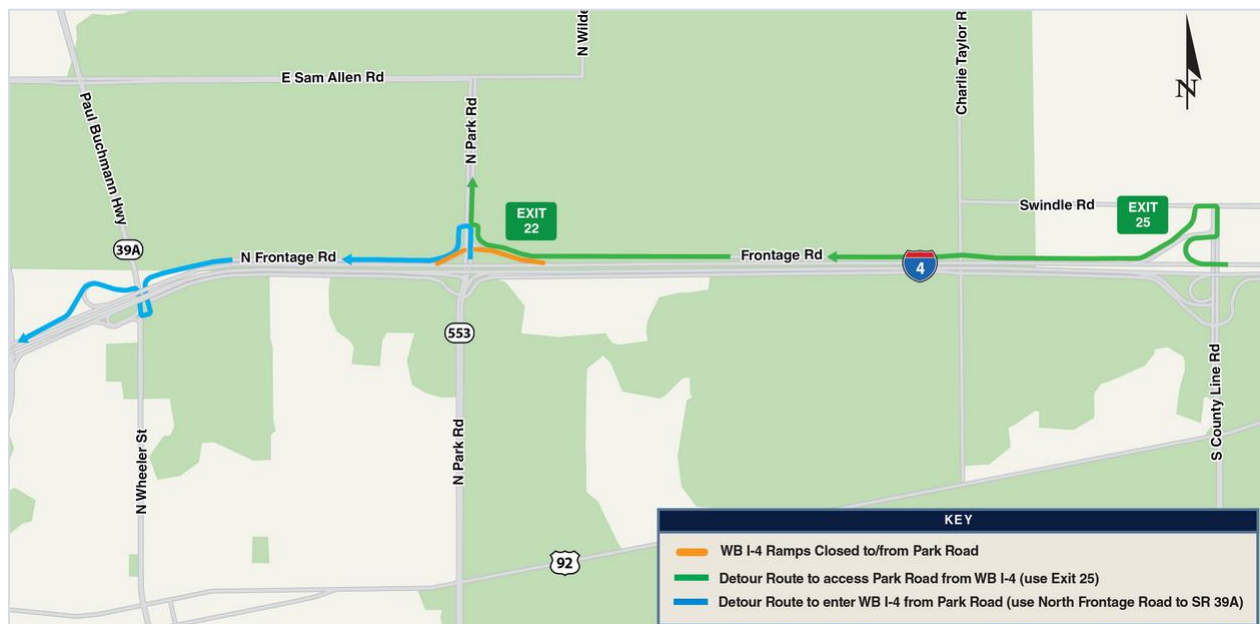

Westbound I-4 Ramps at Park Road Closing this Weekend

Tampa, FL – Beginning at 9 p.m., Friday, May 17, the Florida Department of Transportation’s contractor, Hubbard Construction Co., will close the westbound I-4 ramps (entrance and exit) at Park Road in Hillsborough County. Westbound I-4 ramps should reopen by 5 a.m., Monday, May 20, weather permitting.



Westbound I-4 motorists needing to access Park Road will have to exit the interstate at Exit 25, turn north onto County Line Road, proceed west onto North Frontage Road from Swindell Road, and continue west toward Park Road.

Motorists needing to access westbound I-4 from Park Road will have to proceed west onto North Frontage Road, turn north onto SR 39A (Wheeler Street/Paul Buchman Highway), and enter the interstate using the westbound I-4 entrance ramp.

Electronic message boards and signage will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists should use caution while driving through each work zone and remain alert for construction workers.

These temporary ramp closures are part of the I-4 repaving project from east of McIntosh Road to County Line Road in Hillsborough County. For more information on this project or to sign up to receive traffic alerts, please visit FDOTTampabay.com.
