### **Westbound I-375 Entrance Ramp from 8th Street North Closing Nightly**

St. Petersburg, FL – Beginning Monday, July 22 and Tuesday, July 23, the westbound I-375 entrance ramp from 8<sup>th</sup> Street North will close nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., weather permitting.

During these temporary ramp closures, motorists will continue north on 8<sup>th</sup> Street South, turn west onto Alt 19/5<sup>th</sup> Avenue North and enter the interstate using the westbound I-375 entrance ramp.

Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists should expect delays and congestion during this detour.

These temporary ramp closures are necessary as part of the I-375 concrete pavement repair project from I-275 to 4th Avenue North in Pinellas County. Construction activities are expected to finish in 2026.
