Southbound I-275 Entrance Ramp from 26th Avenue South Closing Nightly

St. Petersburg, FL – On Thursday, July 25 and Sunday, July 28, the southbound I-275 entrance ramp from 26th Avenue South will close nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., weather permitting.

During these temporary nighttime ramp closures, motorists will turn south on US 19/34th Street South and enter the interstate using the southbound I-275 entrance ramp.

Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists should expect delays and congestion during this detour.

These closures are part of the I-275 concrete pavement repair project from 54th Avenue South to 5th Avenue South in Pinellas County. Construction activities are expected to finish in early 2026.
