Southbound I-275 Ramp (Exit 17) to 54th Avenue S/ Pinellas Bayway Closing Nightly

St. Petersburg, FL – Beginning Monday, July 22 through Wednesday, July 24, the southbound I-275 ramp (Exit 17) to 54^{th} Avenue South and the Pinellas Bayway (SR 682) will

close nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., weather permitting.

During these closures, southbound I-275 motorists needing to access 54th Avenue South or the Pinellas Bayway will exit the interstate using Exit 19, turning west onto 22nd Avenue South, south onto US 19 (34th Street South), and continuing south toward 54th Avenue South and the Pinellas Bayway.

Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists are reminded to use caution when traveling through the work zone and remain alert for construction workers.



These closures are necessary as part of the I-275 concrete pavement repair project from 54th Avenue S. to 5th Avenue S. in Pinellas County. Construction activities are expected to finish in early 2026.
