## Eastbound SR 60 Ramp to Northbound SR 589 (Veterans Expressway) Closing Nightly



Tampa, FL – The eastbound SR 60 ramp to northbound SR 589 (Veterans Expressway) will close nightly from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Wednesday, June 5, Thursday, June 6, and Sunday, June 9 through Tuesday, June 11, weather permitting.

During these nightly ramp closures, eastbound SR 60 motorists will have to stay right at the fork, continue toward the Spruce Street ramp (Exit 1B), make a U-turn at the traffic signal (O'Brien Street), and proceed west on Spruce Street toward the SR 589 (Veterans Expressway) ramp.

Motorists should use caution while traveling through the work zone and remain alert for construction workers. These temporary closures are necessary for crews to perform overhead bridge work activities.

The \$45.5 million project is adding one westbound SR 60 (Memorial Highway) travel lane from the George J. Bean Parkway to the Courtney Campbell Causeway and constructing a new flyover ramp from westbound SR 60 to the Independence Parkway near the Tampa International Airport. Construction activities are expected to finish in the spring of 2025.
